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2. Wilshire Park Intervention Space

The successful acquisition of ADSIS funds will require new instructional space for reading intervention. Due to the lack of class room space, we are forced to become creative in utilizing other spaces. Principal Kari Page is proposing to use the stage space in the cafeteria area. A door will be installed across the front of the stage that can be opened and closed and is sound proof. The HVAC and lighting will also be updated. The space is large enough so that learning stations can be created to maximize the use of Read 180, the instructional product. The stage will continue to be used for the music program which includes weekly use by the choir and theatrical productions in the spring. The project is planned to be completed by October 21, 2013.

3. Referendum Questions

Superintendent Laney briefly reviewed the referendum discussion from the July 16th meeting. The referendum decision will be reviewed at the August 12th meeting.

4. Technology Replacement Cycle

As requested by the Board at the July 16th meeting, Superintendent Laney reviewed a proposed technology replacement cycle. He outlined the costs involved to maintain, upgrade, and/ or replace what the district is currently using.

Superintendent Laney held interviews for the Director of Business Services position. He is confident in the three finalists that were chosen and looks forward to making a decision by the end of the week.

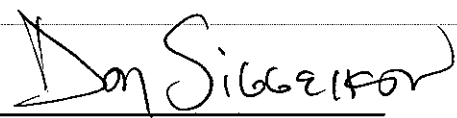
